- Abstract should not exceed 300 words including key words.
- The University has a strict Anti- Plagiarism policy; therefore the authors must ensure originality of the work (Tolerance limit is 10%)
- Plagiarism report and copyright (if any) to be attached.
- All the authors of the paper must have to register separately
- Participation and presentation certificates will be issued to participants during valedictory session..
